SENIORS

Fines/Fees Reminder: If you owe lunch money, library fines/fees, etc., it has to be paid before May 11. Your diploma will not be mailed if you owe money, books, etc.

A+ Reminder: Seniors MUST get your tutoring log sheets signed by the teacher and get them turned in by FRIDAY!

A+ Cord: Seniors who would like to wear an A+ cord at graduation will need to purchase one in the HS office. \$8 new, \$5 old. Students who qualify for A+ will be announced at Senior Spotlight, but not at graduation.

Dual Credit: If you took a DC class from Lincoln but you are not attending Lincoln next year, you must request that your transcript be sent from Lincoln to the school you are going to attend. If you are not currently taking any DC class but did in the past, send this request now. If you are currently enrolled in a DC class, send this request after the semester ends so your current classes are on the transcript. There is a charge so be prepared to pay.

Final Transcript Request: You MUST give Mrs. Mueller a final transcript request so she can send your transcript that says 'graduate' to the school you will attend in the fall. You can't attend that school until they have that transcript.

Playing a sport in college: NCAA or NAIA will want a final transcript! Add their name to the paper you turn in to Mrs. Mueller or fill out another Fatima transcript request.

Attending Lincoln this Fall: If you have an 18 or above ACT and a 3.0 GPA, you qualify for the Heart of Missouri Scholarship for \$2000 per year. You should get this automatically when you apply. If you haven't received it, see Mrs. Mueller.
