Seniors majoring in horticulture, agriculture, conservation, or forestry and going to a college, tech or trade school: Apply for the Master Gardener Scholarship. Three \$1000 scholarships will be given. Deadline is Feb 28. Must have a 3.0 GPA. Mueller has the form.

Three Rivers Members: apply for the Gilbert G. Hilkemeyer Scholarship for \$2000 renewable for a total of 2 years. Deadline is April 2 to have it to Linn. Mueller has the forms, or go to www.threeriverselectric.com.
