LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP and a good one! If you have a 23 or above ACT, a 3.5 or above GPA, and have an EFC on the FAFSA of less than \$6,500: Apply for the Hagan Scholarship. Deadline is Nov 15 at midnight. It will take some effort to put together, so don't procrastinate! Go to www.hsfmo.org for more information. Make sure you follow all directions EXACTLY! This is for \$12,000 a year plus a \$15,000 Schwab Investment Account and a fully paid Study Abroad award. CHECK IT OUT NOW!

A scholarship that does not consider financial need, class rank, act score or basically any requirements: Join the Vantage Credit Union by setting up an account with at least \$5 in it and apply for one of ten \$1000 scholarships. After the scholarship winners are drawn, you can withdraw your money or continue to be a member of their credit union. Go to vcu.com/qfe to fill out the form. Deadline is Jan 11.

Seniors: Apply for the project 21 Article, poster or video contest. Must be shown or displayed by Feb 15 and submitted by March 1. Chance to win up to \$2,500. Mueller has the cover sheet and more details or go to www.missouricasinos.org for more information.
