Juniors planning on majoring in industrial electricity or the lineman program at State Tech: Need a summer job, working as lawn and equipment/truck maintenance at a local power company? Keep the summer job for two summers, and then possibly have a full-time position when you finish at State Tech! Let Mueller know if you are interested in this, and I will give you the details and the person's number to call.

Seniors with a 2.5 or above GPA: Apply for the MOACAC Braxton Rethwisch Scholarship: Looking for kids who exhibit a commitment to learning and have demonstrated leadership skills and community service involvement. Must enroll in a MOACAC member post-secondary institution, but almost all schools in Missouri are on the list. Five one-time \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded. Seniors majoring in insurance, risk management or actuarial science courses. Apply for the Missouri Insurance Education Foundation (MIEF) scholarships. The deadline is March 31, 2019. Four \$1500 scholarships are awarded. Go to the MIEF website for applications.

All Seniors going to a college or university: Pick up the Shelter Insurance Scholarship from Mueller and return to Mueller by March 15.

Both the MFA and Shelter Scholarship are due back to Mueller by March 15. YOU MUST TURN IN A SENIOR PICTURE WITH EACH OF THEM! Someone from Fatima will be the recipient!

Schwartz Scholarships: If you qualify for the Schwartz scholarships, a packet will be handed to you before the week is over. They need to be completed by March 21.

Education Majors: pick up the Stieferman Scholarship and the Blue Jean Scholarships. These are just for Fatima students.

Seniors who have participated in at least one sport at Fatima: Apply for the Athletic Booster Club Scholarship. Mueller has the forms which are due back on April 10. This is one just for Fatima students.

Seniors who participated in a MSHSAA sanctioned sport for 3 years and lettered for 2: if you have a 2.5 cum GPA, apply for the Angela Berhorst Memorial Scholarship. Mueller has the forms. Due back to Mueller on April 1. This is one just for Fatima students.

Students going to a two-year school right after high school who plans to major in graphic arts or related field, history, culinary arts, or a medical field such as nursing, physical therapy, radiology, etc: Apply for the \$500 Michael A. Kremer Memorial Scholarship. Mueller has the form – must be back by April 1. This is one just for Fatima students.

8<sup>th</sup> through 11<sup>th</sup> grade students interested in a science, technology, engineering or math type degree: Consider applying for the FREE MoDot Youth Transportation Conference held July 14-19 at LU in Jefferson City. Thirty students from across the state get a once-in-a-lifetime experience learning about the world of transportation through hands-on activities and lots of tours. You could make concrete canoes, tour the science center, or participate in numerous other exciting activities. Seniors majoring in a field related to banking: Apply for the Missouri Bankers Foundation Scholarship. I don't see the amount. Must be POSTMARKED by March 8, and before it is postmarked it must be signed by a MBFA Banker. The Maries County Bank is a member and willing to sign. Other banks might be also.

All seniors: Apply for the Richard and Jeanne Cavender Scholarship. Two \$500 scholarships will be given. Must be POSTMARKED by March 8. Mueller has the form.

Seniors going to tech school or college: If you or your parents are a member of the Missouri Credit Union, apply for one of their 16 \$2500 scholarships by March 22 at 4:00. To apply, go to <https://missouricu.org/college-scholarships>.

Missouri Courage Award (MCA) is for Missouri students who have demonstrated their commitment and show great potential to work for change in their community that advances the lives of LGBTQ people and other social justice causes. Awards range from \$1,000 to \$3,000. The application is open now on our website: <http://courage-scholarship.org>. The deadline for submission is March 31, 2019

Students who plan to major in horticulture, ag, conservation, or forestry at a college, university, tech, or trade school: Apply for the Master Gardener Scholarship - three \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to three students that reside in Callaway, Cole, Moniteau, Osage, Maries and Miller counties. Seniors going to tech school in a field related to engineering/construction/heavy equipment: apply for the Higgins Quarry Scholarship. Mueller has the form. This is a local – somebody from Fatima will win! Return to Mueller by March 20.

Students going to tech school or college majoring in engineering, architecture, construction management, or a construction-related skilled trade: Apply for the Septagon \$500 scholarship. Mueller has the form. Must be postmarked by March 31.

All Fatima Students going to tech school or college: Apply for the Megan Boehm Memorial Scholarship. Deadline is back to Mueller by March 20. Amounts vary.

Students wanting to become physicians: Apply for the \$1000 JCMG Health Sciences scholarship. Mueller has forms, and you must return them to her by March 18.

Going to tech school or college in a field related to construction: Apply for the AGCMO Education Scholarship for \$2000 if going to college or vo-tech school or \$1000 if going for a certification program. Must be postmarked by March 1. Mueller has the form or go to [www.agcmo.org](http://www.agcmo.org).

Seniors: If you or your parents are members of the River Region Credit Union, apply for their scholarship by April 12. Mueller has the form.
