RE: Fruit Delivery, Sorting and Load out

The Fatima FFA has selected Liberty Fruit Company as their fruit supplier this school year. The chapter also decided that profits could be increased if they brought the produce in large boxes and sorted the fruit once it has been delivered. Liberty will be delivering fruit to the Ag. Dept Sunday, December 6th, at 8:00 a.m.

What does this mean to members and parents?

1. It will take a group effort to make this years fruit sales a success, when you show up **be prepared to help.**
2. Nobody will be allowed to load out, until all fruit is unloaded, counted and sorted.
3. Students will be asked to sign a sheet upon arrival and remain at the Ag.Dept. The load out will be based on this order. **If a student leaves (unless at the request of the Instructor) their name will be crossed off the list and will have to resign-up upon re-arrival.**
4. Ms. Corson and Mr. Rieke will count the fruit this year.
5. Only one person at a time will be allowed to load out and the order will have to be checked by Ms. Corson or Mr. Rieke before leaving.
6. **Do not expect to just show up during load out time and be loaded immediately!**
7. Students and parents are expected to pick up and deliver the fruit A.S.A.P. to prevent excessive spoilage.
8. If all deliveries can't be made in one day, please transport and store the fruit to insure it does not freeze.

Tentative load out for Sunday will be from 11:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The advisors will also be available to load out Monday - Wednesday from 3:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. If your time is limited later Sunday afternoon or one of the evening pick-up times maybe more sutiable/appropriate for your schedule. Money can be turned in to Ms. Corson or Mr. Rieke in the Ag. Dept.
